## New chapter, new space for law firm

BOUTIQUE KZN law firm Cox Yeats Attorneys recently moved to a new purpose built architecturally designed building in the heart of the uMhlanga Ridge precinct.

Cox Yeats Attorneys, a proudly KwaZulu-Natal grown brand with more than five decades in business, was one of the first law firms to relocate from Durban's CBD to uMhlanga Ridge about 10 years ago.

But the firm's growth saw the number of professionals increasing more than three fold over the past nine years, resulting in the decision to build new premises.

Ncondo Chambers comprises eight floors consisting of approximately 8 500m<sup>2</sup> of office space.

Cox Yeats Attorneys occupies the 6th, 7th and 8th floors of the building, which has its own parkade.

The building was designed in conformity with mid-century modern architecture, with elements such as flat planes, large windows and an integration with nature.

Dean Jay Architects designed the building and Vulindlela Holdings was the developer and project manager.
